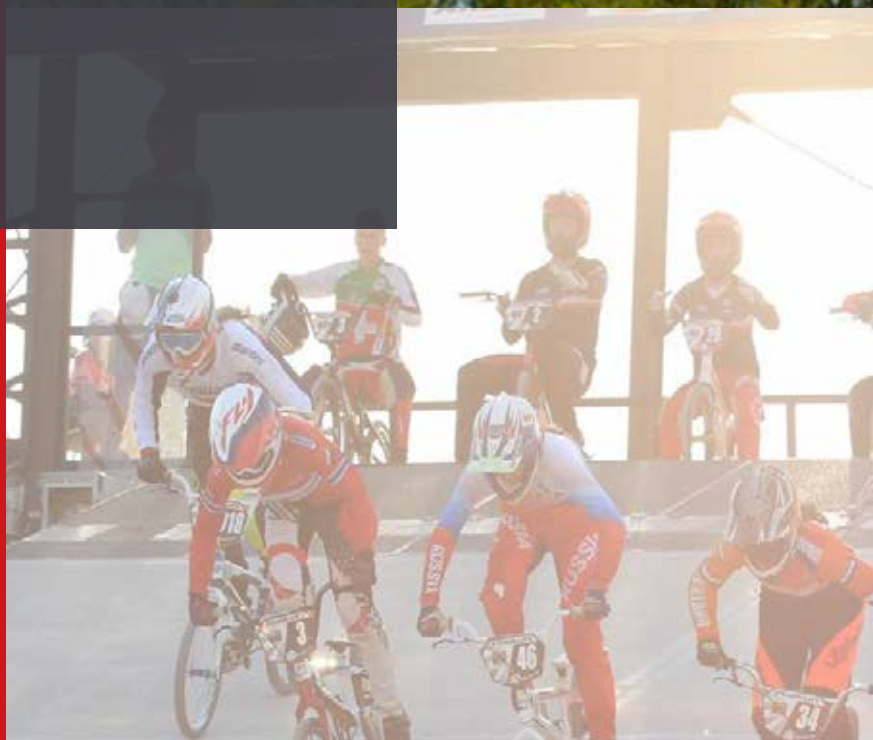

1. Introduction

BMX Norway and the town of Sandnes is honored to welcome you to UEC BMX European cup round 9 and 10.

BMX Norway has a long history of hosting large events going back to the BMX World championship in 1991. Our last event was the UCI Supercross series held in Randaberg arena.

This time we would like to invite you all to Velde Arena just outside the town of Sandnes. The track was finished in 2013 and has been one of Scandinavia's most challenging tracks for both BMX and Supercross. The organization is a partnership of five local clubs and the track is the home track of Tore Navrestad and Silje Fiskebekk, the fastest riders in Norway at the moment for Men and women.

2. Velde Arena Sviland BMX

The track Velde Arena consist of two start hills and 3 double straights.

The Supercross track has a 8m hill and consists of a pro section and rhythm section. The 5m hill is as steep and challenging as an SX start just lower.

The track is know for great flow and big open turns, making for great racing.

80% of the track is covered in bricks so the track is super fast.

Practice: The track will be open for free practice until Wednesday 14.06.17, The area also offer 4 other track within 20min of driving. All tracks offer free practice.

6. Rules

The UEC BMX European Cup 2017 is open to any rider from any country with a national license, in compliance with the UCI regulations. There is no limit on the number of riders from one country that can be registered. The race will be run under the UEC 2017 regulations. Championship riders can score UCI points for their country ranking. Saturday and Sunday is an C1 contest.

PLEASE BEWARE: in case of special conditions (weather, wind or else) or a high number of participants, the UEC BMX Commission allows the PCP in agreement with the UEC Technical delegate to reduce the number of moto's. This can only apply for challenge classes and never for championship classes.

Challenge riders are not allowed to have a number on their jersey nor national sleeves. Career numbers on shirts are only allowed for Championship riders.

Challenge and Championship riders are not allowed to have UCI logo or rainbow stripes on bicycles or clothing, except for Junior and Elite World Champions.

Jeans are not allowed in all classes.

Only riders aged 13 and older are allowed to use clip pedals.



Front and side plates : colors and sizes as per UCI rule book article 6.1.072. Since photo finish system is utilized, each bicycle entered into competition must display a lateral number plate located just behind the steer tube. The number shall be black with a white background.

The riders must display the number assigned to him. It is the responsibility of the rider to check he has the correct number on his plate. No correct number or no correct plate means : no authorization to start and then REL.

7. Registration

All registrations & payments for riders must be made through their own national BMX federation. This ensures that registrations & payments are coordinated.

Late registration after National Federation deadline is not possible!
National federations most mail their registrations to: entrybmx@uec.ch

The Federations can cancel riders until the Thursday 8.00 a.m. before the event. They will not have to pay for this registration. If the riders do not show up at the event and do not cancel their participation in due time entry fee will have to be paid by the national delegate.

- Men Elite Male riders 19 years and older
- Women Elite Female riders 19 years and older
- Men Junior Male Riders 17 and 18 years old
- Women Junior Female riders 17 and 18 years old

Challenge classes :

- Boys: 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 (**minimum age 11 years old**) – combined classes if less than 5 riders
- Girls: 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 (**minimum age 11 years old**) – combined classes if less than 5 riders
 - Men: 17/24, Men 25+
 - Women 17+
 - Cruisers: 17/29, 30/39, 40/44, 45+
 - Cruiser Women: 17 + (1 combined classes)

Min age is 11 due to Norwegian sports law!!!!

10. Numberplates and sideplates

All riders need to bring their own number plate and side plate. This will ***not*** be provided by the organizers.

Side plate is mandatory due to video scoring and timekeeping.

For the Overall ranking Championship classes/Teams:

Trophies and flowers presented to top three. This ceremony will be held directly after the ceremony of the Sundays race.

14. Team Area

UEC Registered teams

Teams that want to participate in the UEC Team Competition must register before 15 March and they pay €200,00 to the UEC. Teams only receive passes during the events when they enter the team competition of the weekend.

Teams register final 4 team riders that participate in team competition on Friday during registration (11:00-14:00).

BMX Norway will provide to UEC registered teams:

Spaces for team tents, as close as possible to the track, of 6 x 3 m for each team registered for that specific race, at the cost of 1500 NOK.

The organizer will receive a list of the UEC after registration is closed of the teams who are registered for the race and will need a team space.

Promote the name of the Team during races as listed on the moto sheets.

Teams receive the following passes at the event from the organizer when they enter the team competition:

1x Team manager pass- with the following rights:

- Free entry to track (event)
- 1 Pass auto (reserved car park for the Team Pit lane)
- Entry to staging
- Entry to track (in case of crashed rider)
- Entry to Team manager meeting
- Entry to Team manager area

1x pass Assistant team manager pass - with the following rights:

- Free entry to track (event)

1x Pass auto (reserved car park for the Team Pit lane)

Other teams

BMX Norway will provide spaces for team tents to non-UEC registered teams, of 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of 2000 NOK.

These teams receive the following passes at the event from the organizer:

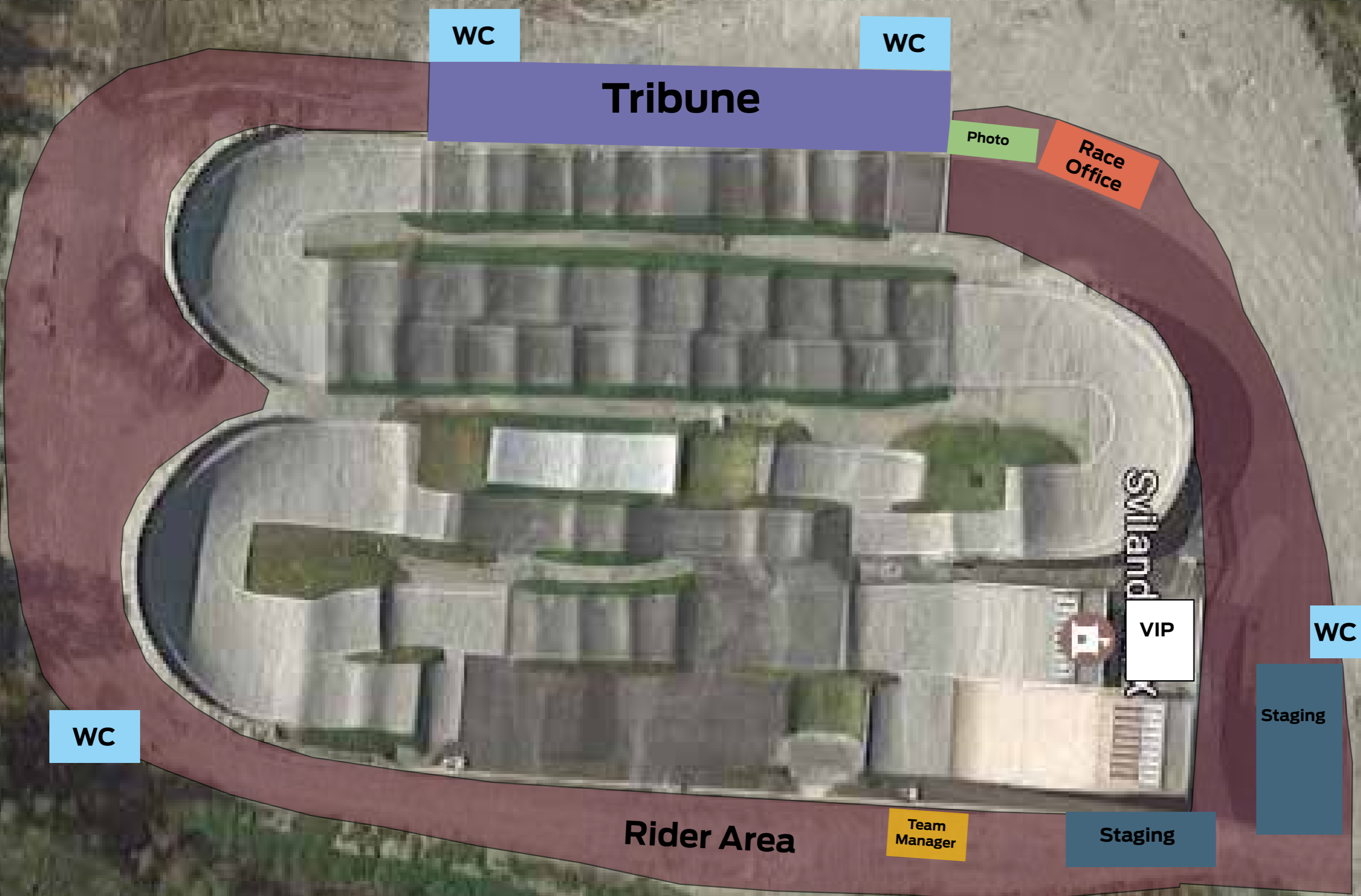
