The track is approximately 380 metres long and with a width of four to six metres. The gate system is the product of the accredited UCI BMX gate providers. It can hold up to 8 riders. The track consists of three turns and seven to eight obstacles.

The race is designed according to UCI rules.

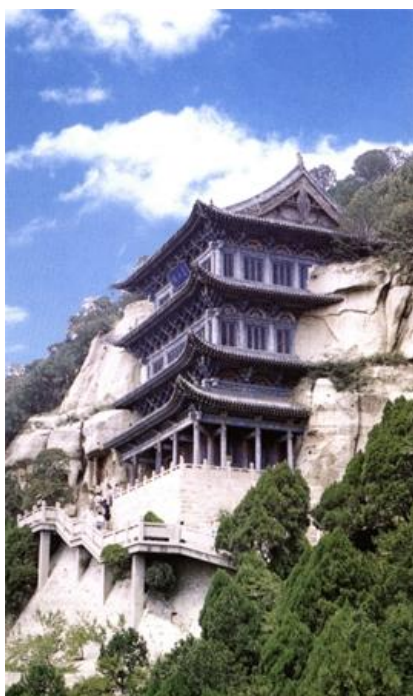
## Racing
